Welcome to the St Cedd's School Lunchtime Concert at Chelmsford Cathedral.

St Cedd's School is an independent day school for boys and girls from Nursery age to Year 6 based in New London Road, Chelmsford. The school is a member of the Choir Schools Association and it has close links with Chelmsford Cathedral. We are very proud that there are a number of St Cedd's School pupils who are Choristers in the Cathedral Choir. Both the St Cedd's School Junior Chamber Choir and Senior Chamber Choir sing Evensong at Chelmsford Cathedral each term.

Music is an important part of daily life at St Cedd's School. All pupils sing every day, Year 2 pupils onwards learn to play the recorder, and there are currently in the region of 140 instrumental lessons which take place each week (taught by our brilliant team of visiting music teachers). Each week our Chamber Choirs, String Orchestra, Wind Band and other groups provide training in ensemble performing, help pupils to improve their skills, and let them gain a sense of fulfilment through making music with others.

Currently we have two pupils who have recently become members of the National Youth Choir of Great Britain. We also have four Year 6 pupils studying for Grade 8 Recorder and a good number of pupils who have already been awarded Music Scholarships or Music Awards this year in preparation for their entry into Secondary Schools in September.

Today's concert gives us a chance to showcase some of the best music making from our ensembles and gives a selection of our Year 5 and 6 instrumentalists a wonderful opportunity to perform solos and small chamber items in the beautiful setting of Chelmsford Cathedral. We do hope that you enjoy our concert.
