Emma Gibbins has been Director of Music at Chelmsford Cathedral since September 2024. She studied at Cambridge University and the Royal College of Music and has held various positions including Associate Organist at St Sepulchre-without-Newgate, the National Musicians' Church, St George's Church in Belfast and Newport Cathedral in South Wales. Since moving to Chelmsford, she has been focusing on rebuilding the chorister sections of the Cathedral Choir and expanding the Cathedral's musical outreach.

Samuel Bristow has served as Assistant Director of Music at Chelmsford Cathedral since September 2023. In this role he acts as the principal organist to the Cathedral's daily liturgy, assists in the running of the Cathedral choirs and oversees the flourishing lunchtime concert series.



He graduated from the Royal Birmingham Conservatoire with First Class Honours in 2019, having studied with Daniel Moulton and Henry Fairs, and has held organ scholarships at the cathedrals of St Paul's, Salisbury, Birmingham and Coventry. In addition to his work at the Cathedral, Samuel remains active as a recitalist, composer and teacher.
