## THE PARISH OF THE CATHEDRAL CHURCH OF CHELMSFORD

### ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING AND ELECTION OF CHURCHWARDENS

will be held in **ON LINE (ZOOM)** from the Cathedral  
on **SATURDAY, 22 MAY, 2021**  
at **9.30AM**

For the election of Parochial representatives of the laity as follows:

- Two Cathedral Wardens

For the consideration of:

- (a) A Report on changes in the electoral roll since the last annual meeting;
  - (b) A Report by the Dean on the activities of the Cathedral;
  - (c) A Report on the annual accounts of the Cathedral for the year ending on the 31st December;
  - (d) A Report on the maintenance of the Cathedral
  - (e) A Report on the proceedings of the Deanery Synod;
- and other matters of parochial or general Church interest.

#### NOTES

1. All persons whose names are entered upon the Church Electoral Roll of the parish and residents of the parish whose name is entered in the register of local government electors are entitled to vote at the election of churchwardens.
2. All persons whose names are entered upon the Church Electoral Roll of the parish (and such persons only) are entitled to vote at the election of parochial representatives of the laity.
3. Subject to the provisions of rule 14(3)(c), a person is qualified to be elected a parochial representative of the laity if
  - a) his name is entered on the Church Electoral Roll of the parish;
  - b) he is an actual communicant which means that he has received Communion according to the use of the Church of England or of a Church in communion with the Church of England at least three times during the twelve months preceding the date of the election;
  - c) he is of eighteen years or upwards (for election to the deanery synod).
  - d) he is not disqualified as referred to in paragraph 3 of these notes.
3. A person is disqualified from being nominated, chosen or elected from
  - a) serving as a churchwarden or any synod under these rules if he is disqualified from being a charity trustee under section 72(1) of the Charities Act 1993 and the disqualification is not for the time being subject to a general waiver by the Charity Commissioners under subsection 4 of that section or to a waiver by them under that subsection in respect of all ecclesiastical charities established for purposes relating to the parish concerned.
  - b) serving as a churchwarden if he has been so disqualified from holding office under section 10(6) of the Incumbent (Vacation of Benefice) Measure 1997.
4. Any person whose name is on the electoral roll may be appointed as a sidesperson.
