The London North-East Fellowship Band of The Salvation Army was formed in 1985 and is the longest established fellowship band in the SA UK Territory. It was founded by Bandmaster Harold Sadler and was originally known as the East London Over Sixty Band.

It's purpose is to encourage fellowship between Salvation Army bandsmen and some non SA bandsmen from East London and Essex who have retired from work but wanted to make music together regularly. Today the band also includes a few members who are still working but are able to manage their time to attend rehearsals and engagements.

In the Band's 39 year history it has had 4 leaders, Harold Sadler, Derek Jordan, Ken Hillson and Max Weaver, who assumed responsibility in September 2019.

Today members of the band travel considerable distances at their own expense to attend fortnightly rehearsals at Hadleigh Temple Salvation Army and concerts for Senior Citizens' Clubs, Salvation Army Corps and Churches within the Essex area from locations such as Barking through to Chelmsford and Great Wakering.

In the past the band has provided concerts at places such as Derby, Coventry, Eastbourne, Lincoln and Deal. It has also taken part in the annual Christmas Carol Service at Stansted Airport.
