## **Meet the Musicians**

Dynamic Scottish saxophonist **Rob Hall** has teamed up with two of Germany's most outstanding jazz musicians, the renowned guitarist **Philipp van Endert** and exciting German pianist **Tobias Weindorf**, to present a programme of lyrical & adventurous new music. With their extensive touring experience, they have produced dozens of recordings with the participation of luminaries such as Kenny Wheeler, Jim Mullen, Lee Konitz, and between them composed new music from soloists to orchestras.

Tret Trio formed in 2022 with the ambition to explore the more unusual combination of two harmony instruments with saxophone. They have appeared at clubs, arts centres, churches and festivals in Germany and the UK and plan to release their debut recording in early 2025.

Multi-reeds player **Rob Hall** has been active on the UK jazz and contemporary music scene for over thirty years. Multiple recordings for the FMR improvised music label include six albums in collaboration with Scottish pianist Chick Lyall. As composer, his work has been published by, amongst others, Stainer & Bell (Clifton Edition), BrassWind and Trinity College London.



Guitarist **Philipp van Endert** is a leading voice in the European modern jazz scene. His energetic and lyrical guitar playing is documented on over fifty recordings and has brought him together with jazz greats such as Mike Stern, Danny Gottlieb & Rick Margitza. A graduate of the renowned Berklee College of Music USA, tours, festivals and productions have taken him to America, Africa and Europe.

**Tobias Weindorf** studied with internationally acclaimed jazz pianist John Taylor at the Cologne University of Music. He has since become a well-known figure on the German jazz scene and has made various CDs, concerts, festival appearances and radio productions, many under his own name. He has toured Europe with Joey Cape, the singer of the group Lagwagon, and has played as a sideman with such artists as Ack van Rooyen, Fay Claassen and Paul Heller.
